### **Open Class Sheep Lead**

**Judging:** Thursday, July 30 – 5 p.m.  
(Carousel Park – East End)

#### **Premiums**

**\$3.00 to all participants**

#### **Rules**

- A. Entries due July 1. Entries not turned in by Monday, July 1 will be assessed a \$10 late fee. If you enter the contest and decide not to participate, you will need to notify the superintendent and the Fair office prior to 6 p.m. Monday of fair.
- B. Sheep Lead essays must be turned in by 6 p.m., Monday of Fair. Essays are to be **typed** (no more than ½ page, double spaced). Public revue and awards presentations will be in the Carousel Park (east end). Sheep Lead is an open class show aimed at presenting **Wool** in a stylish and attractive manner to include the overall picture of the showman and the sheep.
- C. Class 5 – Primary: The only requirements for this class is for the contestant to **wear an item made of wool** such as a ribbon, scarf, hat or purse). Primary participants may be assisted for safety reasons.  
Class 6 – Tiny Tots: Is a participation class only, primarily for fun, and a learning experience. The Tiny Tot class is not required to wear a wool item. Primary participants may be assisted for safety reasons.
- D. Score sheets will be available at the Fair office for contestants upon completion of the contest.

#### **Outfit Rules (Adults, Sr., Int., Jr.)**

- A. Contestants must provide their own outfit. Outfit may be handmade or purchased.
- B. Outfit must be at least **50% wool!**
- C. A brief essay is required. The essay **must** provide information about.
  1. The outfit (description in detail, color, etc.).
  2. Activities, interests and hobbies, etc. of the contestant.
  3. Contestants must tell about lamb and sheep interest.

#### **Class No.**

1. Adult
2. Senior (14-19 years of age as of Jan.1 of current year).
3. Intermediate (11 to 13 years of age as of Jan. 1 of current year).
4. Junior (8-10 years of age as of Jan. 1 of current year).
5. Primary (5-7 years of age as of Jan. 1 of current year).
6. Tiny Tot (2-4 years of age as of Jan. 1 of current year).

Champion and Reserve Champion will be named in the Senior, Intermediate and Junior classes. Participation prizes will be given to the Primary and Tiny Tot classes. Primary and Tiny Tots may have someone walk through with them for security.
