**KIT CARSON COUNTY SPECIAL YOUTH EVENT/AGRICULTURAL SOCIAL DISTANCING AGREEMENT**

**It is requested and advised that all public gatherings and special events conducted in Kit Carson County implement the measures listed below to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus.**

For Kit Carson County residents, our youth engagement/support and agriculture are critical to our well-being and financial solvency. The strategies listed below will be used to assist attendees of your special event to remain safe from exposure to the virus, while being able to enjoy our agricultural and rural heritage. Please check the items that you will implement.

- A method is in place to direct those having symptoms of COVID-19, as well as people who have had close contact with a person who has symptoms (fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, head or body aches) to refrain from participating in any aspect of the event.
- Encourage anyone who is not an exhibitor or an immediate family member to an exhibitor (or event participant) to refrain from attending the show (e.g. Pride of Plains Pig Show, Little Britches Rodeo contestant, etc.)
- A method is in place to screen attendees for signs of illness before being admitted (greeter at entrances to ask if anyone is ill, etc.)
- Individual family units (those living in the same house) must be at least 6 feet apart from other individuals or family units at all times while seated and standing.
- Emphasize the need to refrain from handshaking, handholding, hugging, and other close contact with people who are not directly related to one another.
- Clear communication has been made with those most at risk of severe illness from COVID-19 (people 65 and older, people who have chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma, people who have serious heart conditions, people who are immune-compromised [e.g. cancer], and pregnant people) should follow the guidance of the previous Stay-at-Home order and not attend a large public gathering.
- Hand sanitizer is available at each entrance open to the public.
- Attendees and event staff are urged to wear a mask or cloth face covering over their mouth and nose while attending/performing at the event.
- A plan is in place to disinfect all surfaces before and after any large gathering (please describe).

- Frequently clean and disinfect any regularly touched surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables, chairs, and restroom.
- Identify a workplace safety person who will develop a plan for procurement of cleaning supplies and cleaning practices before and immediately following the event.
- Require gloves and masks or cloth face coverings for workers and event staff who will be in close contact with attendees and/or participants/contestants.
- Digital files rather than paper formats are used for documents including contestant rosters, event schedules, etc.
- The flow of people traffic has been created in order to minimize contact between people (e.g. designate doors for entry or exit only).
- Signage has been made readily visible regarding the need to use hand sanitizer before entering.
- Signage has been clearly posted advising people not to come in if they are ill.

While this local Safer at Home guidance is in place, gatherings of more than 50 people in one room/area are prohibited. We advise continuing to only socialize with members of your household. Any gatherings of 50 or fewer people outside of your household should adhere to all social/physical distancing requirements and recommendations.
