## **PestSweep!**

Colorado State University Extension will be collecting unwanted and outdated pesticides during the week of March 31 through April 4 at various locations. Anyone that wants to get rid of excess pesticides can deliver them at the described locations and dates. This program will accept all pesticides. Costs will be approximately \$7 per pound. Once delivered, wastes will be disposed of through a contracted hazardous waste processor which eliminates these wastes from ending up in local landfills. To date, this program has collected and properly disposed of more than 7000 pounds of hazardous wastes. Collection dates and locations are as follows:

Tuesday March 31 – 1:30 – 3:30: Kit Carson County Fairgrounds

Wednesday April 1 – 1:30 – 3:30: Sedgwick County Fairgrounds

Thursday April 2 – 1:30 – 3:30: Irrigation Research Farm, Yuma

Friday April 3 – 9:30 – Noon: Washington County Fairgrounds
