The purpose of this subdivision is to sell the property for a mobile home getting water and sewer from the Town of Vona.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Kit Carson County, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 15, 2021 and;


