Mini Cattle Showmanship

Judging: Saturday, July 31 – 12 noon

Location: Livestock Show Barn

Check In:

- Miniature cattle may be stalled starting Tuesday by 6 p.m. through Saturday by 9.am.
- To be eligible to be displayed during beef show, immediately following the bucket calf show, miniature cattle must be checked in by 6 p.m. on Tuesday.
- Miniature cattle will be released immediately following the show on Saturday.

Rules

- A. Miniature cattle must be under 48" tall to qualify to show.
Will have 3 classifiers to determine if animal is a mini.
- B. No bulls will be allowed to show.
- C. No clipping on the fair grounds. Clipping must be done prior to being on site at the fairgrounds.
- D. No glue, adhesives or glitter.
- E. Bath and blow dry the day of show.
- F. Show stick and show brush is acceptable.
- G. Show sheen is acceptable.

Dress Code

All exhibitors are expected to dress to project a professional wholesome image.

- No tennis shoes, open toed shoes or sandals.
- No loose fitted, short or revealing clothing.
- No t-shirts or article of clothing with logos or wording.

Judging Criteria

- General Appearance of Animal: Condition of hair and feet, cleanliness, trimming and clipping.
- Showing of Animal: Presenting the animal, poise of showman, skill and ability to move, position and lead the animal.
- Courtesy, Attitude and Appearance of Showman: Knowledge of exhibit.

Class No.

1. 19 years and older (prior entry mandatory)
2. 11 – 18 years of age (prior entry mandatory)
3. 10 years and under (prior entry mandatory).
