Rules

- A. This department will be judged on the Danish system judging system.
- B. Quilts must not have previously been exhibited at the Kit Carson County Fair.
- C. Quilts must have been completed within the past 5 years.
- D. Only one item per class per person is eligible.
- E. Exhibitors are responsible for completing entry tag(s) prior to entry.
- F. Articles on exhibit must be clean, free of odors and pet hair.
- G. All quilts must be able to be hung for display.
- H. Wall hangings must have a hanging sleeve attached.
- I. Names and labels attached to the quilt must be covered.
- J. Person entering item is responsible for removing it from exhibition building.
- K. Fair management will not be responsible for articles left after release time.

Lazy K Coach

Best of Show Judging Criteria

- A. Quality; Beauty; Originality
- B. Best of show exhibits will be predominately displayed and will receive a \$25 cash award unless otherwise specified by sponsor. If no exhibit merits the honor, the award will not be given.

Eligible classes (1-40) **Open Class Quilt Best of Show** is being sponsored by Lazy K Coach.

Definition of a quilt:

1. Three layers – top, batting, backing.
2. Held together by quilting stitches through all three layers.

Quilt Classifications:

- A. Hand Quilted – quilts that are 100% hand quilted.
- B. Machine Quilted – Quilts that are 100% machine quilted.
- C. Appliqued – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top consists of appliquéd motifs applied by either hand or machine.
- D. Hand Embroidered – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is embroidered by hand.
- E. Machine Embroidered – At least 75% of the surface of the quilt top is embroidered by machine.
- F. Miniature Quilts (blocks must be 4" or less) – Quilts that are miniature representations of full-size quilts. Maximum perimeter must be 96" or less. All surface techniques, quilting and finishing should be miniature in scale.
- G. Group Quilts – Combined efforts of two or more persons on a quilt top. At least one person must still be living.

H. Junior Quilts – If 75% or more of a quilt is made by a junior (age 11 & under) or (age 12-18) in collaboration with an adult, it may be entered in the Junior Quilts Division.

I. Art Quilt – Original design only!

J. Kit is defined as fabrics, color choices, design, and pattern that comes in a package and purchased together as a unit.

K. Memory quilts consist of pictures, clothing, memorabilia incorporated into a quilt. (T-shirts would be in this class).

L. Panel quilt will be defined as a quilt using a purchased panel as the focal point.

Hand Quilted – quilts are 100% hand quilted

1. Small (throw or lap size) 60 x 70
2. Medium (full or queen) 80 x 90
3. Large (king) 90 x 100
4. Miscellaneous Quilted Item

Pieced Quilt – quilts that are 100% machine pieced

- All quilting is done by exhibitor
- All work must be exhibitors' own work

5. Small (60 x 70)
6. Medium (80 x 90)
7. Large (90 x 100)
8. Baby
9. Small Quilt from a KIT (fabric, color choices, design, pattern comes together in a package and purchased as a unit – 80" & under)
10. Large Quilt from a KIT (fabric, color choices, design, pattern comes together in a package and purchased as a unit – over 80")
11. Small Quilt using a pre-printed panel (a purchased panel is the focal point - 80" & under)
12. Large Quilt using a pre-printed panel (a purchased panel is the focal point – over 80")

Champion and Reserve Champion Pieced Quilt

Machine Quilted by Professional Quilter – quilter will be recognized on entry tag

- Professional quilter is anyone paid to complete the quilting of the item
- This quilt is a two-person quilt, one piecing and another quilting

Champion and Reserve Champion Professional Quilted

Applique Quilt – at least 50% of the surface quilt top consists of applique motifs

- **Applied either by hand or machine**
- **All work must be exhibitors' own work**

Champion and Reserve Champion Applique

Embroidery Quilt – at least 50% of quilt surface is embroidered

- **All work must be exhibitors' own work**

- 28. Hand Embroidery
- 29. Machine Embroidery

Champion and Reserve Champion Embroidery

Youth Quilts – at least 75% of the quilt is made by a youth under 18 in collaboration with an adult

- **Quilts may be quilted by self or by another person**

- 30. Youth Quilt – age 11 and under
- 31. Youth Quilt – age 12 to 18

Champion and Reserve Champion Youth

Miscellaneous

- **All work must be exhibitors' own work**
- **Wall hangings must have hanging sleeve to be considered a wall hanging**

- 32. Wall Hanging – Pieced
- 33. Wall Hanging – Applique
- 34. Wall Hanging – Mixed Techniques
- 35. Miniature Quilt Blocks – blocks are 4" or less. Maximum perimeter less than 96".

All techniques are miniature in scale.

- 36. Art Quilt – Original Design only!
- 37. Table Runner – Rectangular in shape
- 38. Table Topper – Other Shapes
- 39. Miscellaneous Quilted Item (bag, pillow, tree skirt, etc.)

Champion and Reserve Champion Miscellaneous

History Quilt

40. Using old blocks, family made or purchased at a thrift store, add the work needed to complete the quilt top and finish the quilt. This quilt must have a story attached recording the "history" behind the exhibit. Story not over 1 page, double spaced and in a protective clear sleeve. This story must be displayed with the quilt.
