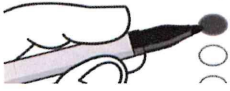


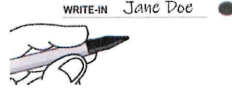

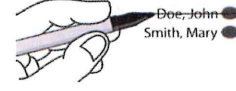
Ballot Type: Property Owner



To vote for a named candidate, or for or against a ballot measure, completely fill in the oval to the right of your choice. Use blue or black ink.



If a race includes a write-in line, you may vote for a write-in candidate by completely filling in the oval to the right of the line and printing at least the last name of an eligible write-in candidate on the line.



To make a correction, draw a bold line through the oval and candidate name or ballot measure selection marked by mistake, then fill in the oval next to the correct name. If you voted for the only candidate in a race and want to withdraw that vote, you must request a replacement ballot.

WARNING: Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges, or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. Section 1-7.5-107(3)(b), C.R.S.

Ballot Measures

Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

Flagler Rural Fire Protection District Ballot Issue 6C

SHALL THE FLAGLER RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED \$50,000 (FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE), ANNUALLY, AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, BY INCREASING ITS EXISTING PROPERTY TAX BY 3.184 MILLS, COMMENCING WITH LEVY YEAR 2025 FOR COLLECTION IN CALENDAR YEAR 2026, FOR A TOTAL MILL LEVY NOT TO EXCEED 5.5 MILLS, EXCLUSIVE OF REFUNDS AND ABATEMENTS, TO BE USED BY THE DISTRICT FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES, MAINTENANCE, EQUIPMENT, UPDATING BUILDING AND OTHER BUDGET EXPENSES, INCLUDING MAINTAINING EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIMES, PROVIDING ESSENTIAL SAFETY AND COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT, AND REPLACING AGING EMERGENCY RESPONSE VEHICLES?
